SUMMARY

Mary Ann O'Grady (now Markey), Ph.D., received her doctorate in 2011 from Nova Southeastern University in south Florida. Previously she graduated with bachelor's and master's degrees from Florida Atlantic University. Since 2010 Dr. Markey has been teaching online classes in Research Methods, Conflict Resolution, and various psychology classes as a member of the adjunct faculty at Grand Canyon University, Southern New Hampshire University, Northcentral University, Ashford University, University of the Rockies, Lewis University, Nova Southeastern University, Southern Utah University, Pitt Community College, Lenoir Community College, and Citizens High School. In 2011 and 2012, Dr. Markey was honored by Grand Canyon University in its Faculty Acknowledgment Program where she was recognized as exceeding the University's expectations in student assistance.

Dr. Markey serves as an article reviewer for Sage Open Journal Publications. She is also a peer reviewer for *Homicide Studies*, the official publication for the Homicide Research Working Group. In 2012 Dr. Markey published the following books: *Filicide: A Conflict Resolution Perspective* (Lambert Publishing, Saarbrucken, Germany), *Thinking the Unthinkable: Examining this Phenomenon Called Filicide* (Inter-Disciplinary Press & Fisher Imprints, Oxfordshire, U.K.), and *Facilitating Authentic Diversity: Developing the Peace Practitioner* (Lambert Publishing, Saarbrucken, Germany). In 2013 Dr. Markey published a book chapter, *Shattered Self-Images: Narcissism, Egotistical Suicide, and School Shooters* in *Gun Violence in American Society: Crime, Justice, and Public Policy* (University Press of America, Washington, D.C.). In 2017 Dr. Markey published a book chapter, *Honor Murders as Crimes Against Women and an International Violation of Human Rights*, in *Dark Denials and Despicable Damage* (Green Legacy Publishing, LLC, Lake Charles, LA). In 2018, Dr. Markey published a book chapter, *A Threat Assessment Model for Posts in the Online Sphere* in *Handbook of Research on School Violence in American K-12 Education* (IGI Global, Hersey, PA). She was also published in the Fall 2018 issue of the IASD journal with the release of her article entitled *Dream Validation or Validation by Dream?* At the present time, Dr. Markey has several other book chapters and books that have already been submitted for publication and/or

under contract with future publication release dates in 2019 and 2020 as detailed under the “Publications” section of this CV.

Dr. Markey had also been invited to present at several conferences during 2014 including the 4th Global Conference on Space and Place (Oxford, U.K.), the 3rd Global Conference on Celebrity and Fandom (Oxford, U.K.), and the 70th Annual Meeting of the American Society of Criminology (San Francisco, Ca). She is co-hosting the 1st International Biophilia Conference in Ireland during the month of June 2018.

ONLINE LEARNING–TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

As an instructor and facilitator, my mission is to provide my students with a quality learning experience that will allow them to maximize their learning potential, and in order to accomplish that goal, I adhere to a student-oriented perspective. My objectives as an instructor, of course, include having my students master the content of the courses that I am teaching, but in addition, I strive to: 1) foster their ability to think critically; 2) facilitate their acquisition of life-long learning skills; 3) prepare them to communicate effectively in an economy that has become based upon a rapid exchange of information and data 24/7; and 4) help them to develop problem-solving strategies that will serve them well throughout their lives. I believe that I share a bi-directional relationship with my students in which learning flows in both directions because there has not been one class in which I have failed to learn from my students. I also feel that each class possesses its own individuality or set of dynamics, so it is imperative that I examine my “audience,” and determine how best to facilitate the class according to the students’ learning styles (active/reflective, sensing/intuitive, visual/verbal, and sequential/global learners) which is the (ILS) framework designed by Felder and Silverman (1988).

I believe that students’ education can be enhanced by offering them the option of taking classes in an online format in addition to taking [traditional] classes on campus or in a hybrid format; in addition, online classes afford a larger number of students the opportunity to participate in a quality college education. Although younger students who have literally grown up with computers and advanced technology seem to be more comfortable with online and hybrid courses, I encourage the older or non-traditional students to enroll in online and hybrid classes as well. I have students who exhibit a high degree of apprehension so in a couple of extreme cases, I have provided one-on-one tutoring so that their concerns over computer hardware and software can be reduced or eliminated. Attempting to learn the course material as well as new computer programs simultaneously can be intimidating to many students.

In order to establish credibility to my students’ perspective of me as their instructor, I make it a point to share my academic history with my students as part of my biography so that they are aware that I have a B.A. and an M.A. in psychology as

well as a Ph.D. in conflict analysis and resolution with an emphasis on crisis management and critical incidents. Emphasizing the unique opportunities provided by these degrees usually serves to open the lines of communication regarding employment opportunities as well as potential research studies. For example, alternative dispute resolution sounds far more interesting when it encompasses hostage negotiation experience; and homicide research seems very intriguing when it involves forensic psychology. The director's position at the Family Center at the Family Violence Program illustrates the practical application of all my degree programs. The filicide research I have been conducting over the past 7 years has led to several fascinating collaborations while we continue to investigate a variety of motives and methods underlying brutality, violence, aggression, domestic violence, homicide, and just recently revenge, which has been added to the queue. To offset the serious nature of my academic pursuits, inclusion of my hobbies and personal interests creates a balance to my work. I find that sharing this other side of my persona establishes commonality with my students who may share my fondness for aerobatic flying, macro and micro photography, arctophily, music, martial arts, sabre fencing, and playing the drums and banjo.
